## Dear Member:

Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Louisiana and our subsidiary, HMO Louisiana, Inc., (collectively referred to herein as BCBSLA), work in partnership with Express Scripts, Inc.,\* an independent pharmacy benefit management company, to administer your prescription drug program. We have put together the *Blue Selections Rx Member Guide*, which we hope will help you understand your pharmacy benefits. Understanding your benefits is key to getting the most from your health plan, since pharmacy benefits may be subject to various copayments, prior authorization requirements, quantity-per-dispensing limitations, and programs such as the specialty pharmacy program and the *Lead with Generics* step therapy program.

BCBSLA maintains a Pharmacy & Therapeutics Committee, a group of local physicians and pharmacists that reviews individual drugs and classes of medications based on safety, efficacy and cost information. The role of this committee is to ensure that, where possible, adequate coverage of medications exists.

The *Blue Selections Rx Member Guide* contains 800 of the most commonly prescribed medications for BCBSLA members. This guide can be found on the website at [www.bcbsla.com/pharmacy](http://www.bcbsla.com/pharmacy). Drugs listed in this guide are not meant to be a complete list of medications covered by your plan. All lists are subject to change and may not apply to all group and individual benefit plans. Some benefit plans may include or exclude coverage for specific medications. Please refer to your member contract/certificate for pharmacy coverage exclusions and limitations. The *Blue Selections Rx Member Guide* applies only to prescription medications dispensed on an outpatient basis by participating pharmacies.

Your plan offers a five-tier copayment structure for covered medications. You will pay the lowest copayment when you use generic drugs (Tier 1) and the highest copayment for multi-source brand (Tier 4) and injectable medications (Tier 5). Tier classifications are described as follows:

Tier 1 – a prescription drug that is primarily a generic drug, although some brand-name drugs may fall into this category.

Tier 2 – a prescription drug that is primarily a brand-name drug, although some generic drugs may fall into this category.

Tier 3 – a prescription drug that is a brand-name drug that may have a therapeutic alternative as a Tier 1 or Tier 2 drug. Covered compounded drugs are included in this tier.

Tier 4 – a brand-name drug for which a generic equivalent is available (i.e., multi-source brand drugs).

Tier 5 (Injectable Drugs) – those medications that are intended to be self-administered. Insulin and injectable antihemophilic prescription drugs may be included in another drug tier.

Please note that any brand-name drug that loses patent protection after the printing of this publication and becomes available as a generic equivalent will require a Tier 4 copayment.

The *Blue Selections Rx Member Guide* displays covered prescription drugs in a table (see sample below). The first column provides the drug name; brand-name drugs are listed in upper case, generic drugs in lower case. The “PA/QPD/SP/ST” column highlights those drugs that require prior authorization (PA), quantity-per-dispensing limits (QPD), specialty pharmacy program restrictions

(SP) or step therapy restrictions (ST). An “X” placed under the specific “Tier” column indicates the specific tier level coverage for a prescription drug. The “Recommended Alternatives” column indicates that a lower copayment alternative drug is available in another tier. In this column, brand-name drugs are listed in upper case and generic drugs in lower case.

In the index, drugs are listed alphabetically with a chapter and section reference to help you locate the drug within the body of the *Blue Selections Preferred Rx Member Guide*.

**ST: Medications requiring participation in the Lead with Generics Step Therapy Program**

In certain drug classes, members are required to first try one prescription drug to treat a medical condition before another prescription drug will be covered for that condition. For example, if Drug A (generic) and Drug B (brand) both treat the member’s medical condition, we may require the member’s physician to prescribe Drug A first. If Drug A does not work for the member, then we will cover a prescription written for Drug B. If based on patient history, the member is unable to tolerate Drug A or the treating physician would like to request Drug B be tried without first trying Drug A, the request will be treated like a prior authorization (see below).

**PA: Medications requiring Prior Authorization**

Certain high-risk or high-cost medications require prior authorization by BCBSLA. Prior authorization criteria have been established by the Pharmacy & Therapeutics Committee after consideration of the current medical literature. Prior authorization requests are processed by Express Scripts. If you need prior authorization for your medication, please have your physician fax or call Express Scripts as follows.

**QPD: Medications subject to Quantity Per Dispensing (QPD) limitations**

Covered prescriptions have a day supply limitation set forth in your member contract/certificate (typically up to a 30-day supply at a retail pharmacy and up to a 90-day supply for mail-order). These limits are additional to the day supply limitation and are based on the manufacturer’s recommended dosage and duration of therapy; common usage for episodic or intermittent treatment; FDA-approved recommendations and/or clinical studies; and/or as determined by BCBSLA. QPD limits/allowances are subject to quantity limits per day supply, per dispensing event or any combination thereof. **SP: Specialty Pharmacy Program restrictions**

Certain drugs are commonly referred to as “specialty drugs.” (Specialty drugs include biotechnology drugs or other drug products that may require special ordering, handling, and/or customer service). Certain policies require members to obtain these drugs at a network specialty pharmacy to receive in-network benefits. Please see your Schedule of Benefits to see if this restriction applies to you.
