

\$0 Drug Copay Program

About the program: We designed our \$0 Drug Copay Program to help members get drugs that treat certain chronic conditions for \$0. The \$0 Drug Copay Program is available for most covered members with a pharmacy copay option (it is not available for coinsurance-only pharmacy benefits). Members do not have to meet a deductible before getting program drugs for \$0.

You may be able to get the drugs on this list for \$0 copay if:

- you have been diagnosed with at least one of these health problems: chronic kidney disease, congestive heart failure, diabetes, pre-diabetes, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, asthma, coronary heart disease or hypertension, **and**
- you are enrolled in a disease management program, **and**
- you talk with your Health Coach as often he or she advises if it is part of your health plan.
