

## \$0 Drug Copay Program

We designed our \$0 Drug Copay Program to help members\* get select drugs that treat certain chronic conditions for \$0. You may be able to get the drugs on this list for \$0 copay if you have been diagnosed with at least one of these health problems: chronic kidney disease, congestive heart failure, diabetes, pre-diabetes, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), asthma and/or coronary heart disease or hypertension (high blood pressure) AND are enrolled in a disease management program. Some members may have additional requirements to get the drugs on this list for \$0.

*\*The \$0 Drug Copay Program is available for most members who pay copays for prescription drugs (it is not available for coinsurance-only pharmacy benefits).*
