



Is your drug covered in 2017?

My drug is not covered. *Now what?*

If you take a drug that is not covered by your health plan, here's what you can do. Before your next fill:

If you are at the pharmacy, ask your pharmacist what drug choices you have.

He or she may tell you if there is an over-the-counter option or prescription drug you can take, so you know what to do next.

1 Check for covered drugs at bcbsla.com/pharmacy.

If a drug is not on the list, it is not covered. Talk to your doctor about other drugs that treat your health problem.

2 Call your doctor.

Ask your doctor to order another drug that is covered by your plan.

If you don't know your doctor's number, you can find it on the BCBSLA mobile app or at bcbsla.com/findcare.

3 Call the Pharmacy number on your ID card.

If you have more questions, you should call the Pharmacy number on your ID card.

Why do I need to do this?

You will save the most on a drug that is covered. You could have to pay the full cost of a drug that is not covered.

What if I can't take any of the covered drugs?

Your doctor may ask for a drug to be covered, if you have a medically necessary need for it. Coverage is not possible for all drugs.
